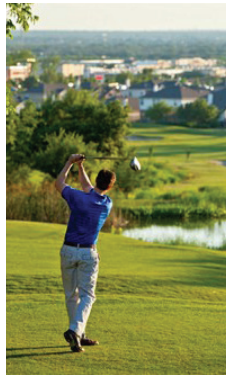

HISTORY & OVERVIEW

Located 25 miles west of downtown Austin, Lakeway is situated on the south shore of Lake Travis. Once a 2,700-ranch owned by a oilman and rancher, the city is now a resort community known for amazing golf courses and Texas Hill Country views.



EDUCATION
